



COVID-19 INFORMATION

SCHEDULING

We will be sending all information both venue and CRU Dance regarding our finalized safety measures/protocols with your preliminary schedule, 2 weeks prior. As stated on our website, we will be doing "block scheduling" to limit capacity to maintain social distancing.

DRESSING ROOMS

In the event that there are 2-3 studios with a small number of routines registered for the event, we may have those studios compete in the same block in which case each studio will be assigned their own dressing room space. Dancers should arrive stage ready for their first performance and should only use the dressing room if they have more that one costume.

If a dancer is not comfortable changing in the dressing rooms provided and would rather wear generic dancewear to compete with all routines, no points will be deducted.

LIVE STREAM

All events will be live streamed to limit the audience capacity while providing an option for those unable or not comfortable to attend with an opportunity to watch the event in real time. Live stream can be located on our website www.cru-dance.com/live-stream. Please note, that some venue capacities may not allow spectators at certain events.

Important: Please be mindful that optimum streaming will rely solely on the strength of the WIFI signal at the host venue. Several factors including WIFI strength, weather conditions, and/or technical difficulties may affect viewing quality and/or interruptions in service. These are factors that are beyond CRU Dance and DanceBug's control and as such we appreciate everyone's patience should service be affected.

PHOTO/VIDEO

-This event will be live streamed.

-Absolutely no photography and videography allowed. Violators of this rule will be asked to leave the premises. This is for the safety of your dancers and choreography. -Photos and videos can be viewed on the DanceBug App and purchased at www.dancebug.com after the event.

SOCIAL DISTANCING PROCEDURES

Judges will sit at separate tables to ensure that they remain 6' apart, yellow tape will outline a 6' area around sound and stage managers, yellow tape will be used to create standing areas 6' apart at retail area as well as a barrier in front of retail tables. Signs will be posted to encourage social distancing and proper hygiene.

Cashless Retail

Credit card will be the only form of payment accepted at CRU Dance retail area and disinfectant wipes will be used to wipe terminal and credit cards during each transaction. The Merchandise area will be a no-touch display, at this time we will not permit the trying on of our garments and merchandise, all merchandise will be handled by CRU Dance Staff until purchased.

CRU Dance retail staff, sound manager, temperature checkers, stage managers will be required to wear latex free gloves while working in their positions.

REQUIREMENTS

Temperature Checks: Host venue may require temperature checks of every person entering the event. Should this be the case, infrared thermometers will be used to perform this function. Any one that registers 100.4 or higher may not be permitted to enter.

Waivers: will be required to be signed by each individual attendee or parent or legal guardian for those under the age of 18 prior to the event.

Masks: All attendees are required to wear a mask or they will not be permitted to enter. No masks will be available, it is required for you to provide your own. CRU Dance staff will be required to wear masks (with exception of judges while judging and emcee while making announcements) for the entirety of the event.

Depending on the venue/state requirements, dancers may or may not have to wear masks while performing on stage.

DEEP CLEANING/SANITIZATION

CRU Dance staff as well as venue staff will conduct a deep clean of the venue following each block segment. This includes the stage, dressing rooms, auditorium, bathrooms and lobby.

Hand sanitizing stations will be located at various points around the venue specifically at venue entrance, retail, backstage (both sides of wings), dressing rooms, sound booth, etc. Dancers will be required to sanitize hands prior to going on stage and immediately following performances.

WINGS

Only 1 routine will be permitted backstage in the holding area at a time and those dancers will only be able to access that area once the routine prior has taken the stage. Please follow markings on the floor in the backstage hallway.

<u>AWARDS</u>

Upon completion of a block segment, awards will be announced in order of performance and one studio representative per routine will be permitted to receive the award. Dancers must be socially distanced onstage, wearing a mask. Depending on venue/state regulations, a virtual awards may occur.
